## Twin Rail Installation Instructions (Drop-In, Lift-Out Style)

- 1. Arrange corner, end, and inline posts as necessary for installation. DO NOT drill mounting holes yet.
- 2. Once arranged, place the bottom rail in the sleeve first for the entire layout. The rail should be loose in the sleeve about  $\frac{1}{4}$ " gap.
- 3. Put the guick release hardware in the bottom rail by:
  - 3a. Line up the holes in the sleeve and the rail (Figure 1)
  - 3b. Open the quick-release hardware by sliding the end of the clip off of the bolt (Figure 2)
  - 3c. Put the bolt through the holes of the rail and the sleeve that were lined up (Figure 3)
  - 3d. Close the quick release hardware (Figure 4)
  - 3e. Repeat steps 3a 3d for the other end of the rail.



- 3. Put chalk line down.
- 4. Move posts to line.
- 5. Put top rail in sleeves.
- 6. Repeat steps 3a 3d to put the quick release hardware on both ends of the top rail.
- 7. Drill one hole at a time and anchor prior to moving to next hole.
- 8. Place nut at the top of the anchor, but do not expose the threads.
- 9. Use a hammer to pound the anchor into the hole until the base of the nut reaches the top baseplate of the post.
- 10. Use an impact wrench to tighten the nut until it is tight.
- 11. Use a rubber mallet to drive on the black, steel cap to the top of each post.
- 12. Done!
